

A modified schedule for continuing students who are changing their major to BS NEUR

Students who entered Georgia Tech prior to spring semester 2017 and who change their major to Neuroscience will find that most of the classes that they have already taken will count for requirements in the BS NEUR degree program (as USG core classes, interest electives, breadth electives and free electives). 2XXX and 3XXX classes that you have taken in your current major might count towards the Breadth electives that might become a minor or a second degree. These students should plan on taking the following courses in the indicated semesters.

Depending on how much credit you already have, you might be able to **finish the curriculum as early as spring semester 2019** if you complete the Research Option. Otherwise, the earliest graduation date is fall semester 2019 (for those students who plan on taking NEUR 4001 rather than complete the thesis option).

What to take over the next 5-6 semesters:

You also need to complete:

- Neuro interest elective (1 class)
- Neuro additional electives (2-3 classes)
- Neuro statistics elective (1 class)
- Breadth electives (~5 classes)
- Any remaining class from the lists above (CHEM, PHYS, MATH, Health, CS, Soc. Sci., Hum.)
- Free electives
